PALETTE: Heritage Paint

Naphthol Red Light	Red Violet	Titanium White	Burnt Umber
Raw Umber	Pine Green	Raw Sienna	Carbon Black
Yellow Oxide	Hansa Yellow	Phthalo Blue

#4 & 6 Filbert	#4 Round	#0 Liner

Mix Paints to Globals:

This design uses the twelve (12) piece starter set.

Global painting is a term to describe when we use the Heritage Multi Media Paints as an oil immolation or like an oil paint. To do this we allow the paint to remain uncovered to about 2 to 3 days and add **Extender** and mix well.

To start place a small amount of paint into your Global palette or a similar palette with an air tight lid.

To each paint compartment mix **Paint + Extender (3:1)**. Stir well with a small coffee stirring stick or a small wooden dowel. Wipe off the color into a paper towel before going into the next color.

Check the paint consistency each day for 3 to 5 days and stir in more **Extender** each day or as needed to keep creamy. Leave uncovered for 2 to 3 days. The paint is now ready and can be covered with a lid between each use. Place palette into a zip-lock baggie and the paint can be kept for many months. Be sure to check periodically and stir in **Extender** as needed to keep the paint consistency creamy.

Be sure while painting with Globals you **“do not use any Water”**. The Water has been evaporated from the paint and replaced with **Extender**. Moisten your brush with **Extender** and clean your brush and **Extender** while painting. Remember **“no Water”**.

PREPARATION:

1. Prepare the surface with one (1) coat of **Wood Sealer**. Then basecoat the surface with **Raw Sienna + Raw Umber + Burnt Umber + Titanium White (3:1:1:2)** or you can use a bottled color such as – Medium Beige if you have this color. You may lighten with White if desired.
2. Transfer the pattern on lightly with Grey graphite.

Leaves:

1. **Green Mixes:** Medium Green - Pine Green + Naphthol Red Light
Dark Green - Medium Green Mix + touch of Carbon Black
Light Green - Medium Green + Hansa Yellow + touch of Titanium White
2. Stroke in your leaves with **Medium Green Mix** with #4 and 6 Filbert brushes.
3. Shade with a stroke of the **Dark Green Mix**. Wipe out your brush and blend slightly.
4. Highlight with strokes of the **Light Green Mix**. Do not over blend.
5. Add **Titanium White** to the **Light Green Mix** and then line the center vein and line the highlight edge
